


Cutting wood




Put a scrap piece of wood in the mitre box. This scrap (martyr) protects the mitre box.



Lean the box against the table.

Insert the saw in the slit of the mitre box.






Cutting wood (continued)

Important

You must check the direction of inclination of the teeth before making a cut. The direction of the cut will determine the position of the piece to be cut in the mitre box.



In this case, lean the part against the back of the mitre box. Hold the longest part firmly before cutting your part.

This method ensures better support and greater stability for the part to be cut.
